As a current elected public official or as a candidate for an elected public office, by meeting the parameters herein, you may participate in one or both of the following parades during the 2024 82nd Annual Preston County Buckwheat Festival.

Friday, September 27th School Community Day Parade

Saturday, September 28th, Farmers' Day Parade

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Entry Fee: \$250.00 per vehicle per parade—limited to two (2) vehicles per parade.

Checks payable to the Kingwood Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. and submitted with your application. Memo Line: "Parade Entry Fee".

Provide: Your own vehicle, driver and signage.

Signage: Your name, office held or candidate for, as applicable
 acknowledge vehicle—"Vehicle Courtesy of....."

NO political or controversial issue(s) may be represented or alluded to in any way on any parade entry.

PARADE DAY:

Line-Up Logistics and Procedures:

Friday, September 27th School Community Day Parade

Line-up time 12:00 noon (DST) Parade begins at 2:00 PM (DST)

Saturday, September 28th, Farmers' Day Parade

Line-up time 10:00 AM (DST) Parade begins at 12:00 noon (DST)

Enter the parade line-up area on East High Street at its intersection with WV Route 7 East (Veterans Memorial Highway) at the Advance Auto Parts store.

You will be assigned a line-up number when you enter the line-up area on East High Street. These numbers are painted on the pavement.

Once lined up, a driver or person in charge **MUST** remain with your parade entry at all times.

The use of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, and/or the misuse of prescription drugs by **any** parade participants before or during the parade(s) is **PROHIBITED** and may result in legal action by the local authorities. **NO** inappropriate language or behavior by **any** parade participant(s), intoxicated or otherwise, **WILL BE TOLERATED.**

Parade Route Procedures:

Maintain forward movement and distance from other parade entries as directed by parade staff/firemen.

NO SOLICITING, THROWING OR HANDING OUT OF ANY ITEMS: Because of the safety hazard it presents, the throwing from floats or other parade entries and/or the handing out of any objects, (Candy, pennies, balloons, printed materials or any other such items.), or soliciting directly to parade participants within the line-up area or spectators along the parade route before or during the parade(s) is **PROHIBITED.**

You **MUST** participate through the entire parade route.

At the end of the parade(s) on South Price Street, KVFD firemen will direct you to **A SPECIFIC SITE TO PARK.** To avoid blocking the flow of the parade(s) and emergency vehicles, **DO NOT PARK** until directed to do so by a KVFD fireman. Once parked, disembark riders as safely and quickly as possible and quickly tear down your parade entry if needed. Once torn down, move out of this parade/festival congested area to make room for other floats and parade entries to accomplish these same tasks. If you do not need to disembark riders or tear down your parade entry, advise the firemen and they will direct you out of town.
